Place-Names of Carmarthenshire: Richard Morgan publication April 2022

Publication is expected to take place in April 2022 and details are now being circulated through <http://welsh-academic-press.shopfactory.com>). The paperback volume and the ebook will both retail at £19.99. *Place-Names of Carmarthenshire* discusses more than 920 place-names and river-names in the historic county of Carmarthen (1536-1974). It follows the same general format as *Place-Names of Glamorgan* with illustrations and maps but the glossary has been expanded to include cross-references to individual place-names containing particular elements. A record of the historic sources cited in the volume will be accessible online.
